## EIGHT RACES TODAY ! !

Count the races at any stadium in the country and you will find it very hard to locate any track where there are eight races on one programme and we think that we can once again say, "We've done it!"

With four meetings on the same day, we have not the same proportion of red-roof drivers as usual, among the seniors, or among the juniors for that matter, but this does not mean that we have no stars. What the national ratings class as stars are not the only ones, so far as we are concerned. Today we have such fine drivers as ROY GOODMAN, DOUG. WARNER, BARRRY HEBBORN, DON EVANS, DARKIE WRIGHT, GEORGE ANSELL, CHIPPIE WESTON and WILLIE WANKLYN booked, in addition to the two red-roof stars, KEN FREEMAN and CHICK WOODROFFE. If that little lot does not supply some action, we don't know what we are saying, and there are also such sterling supporting characters as BRIAN FROST, IAN IRELAND, THE THREE TOON BROTHERS, TED ELLIOTT, THE TWO TAYLOR BROTHERS, GRAHAM RACKLEY and so on, to make sure that things do not get dull !

Next Saturday, we have the television people in, with transmissions from 1-20 to 1-40, 2-55 to 3-10 and 3-25 to 3-40 p.m.; we expect that what the viewers will see will be some pit interviews and the first heat in the earliest transmission, the consolation race in the second broadcast, and the Final of our Television Trophy at 3-25. If you come along, you will see all these, plus the second heat, and any other bits and pieces that we can fit in. There will be some record requests, a couple or more of our spectators' prizes to be won, plus most of the best drivers in the country.

Doors will open at mid-day for a one o'clock warm-up, and you will be able to leave in time to get to the London Junior Championship at Harringay the same evening.

As I am writing this on the same day as I wrote the programme for last Saturday, I still do not know whether 'DIRTY DENNIS' will be with us or not. The name of Burdett-Coutts will be most welcome on the programme, and we hope that he can find his way here after all this while !

On May 5th we have our qualifying round for the Junior World Championship, and we expect to have all the very best men in the ten horsepower division for this important meeting. It is so important that we have left out the team-racing which we were going to feature. We have one of the two semi-finals of this Championship—which we first mooted, by the way—on August Bank Holiday Sunday. There will be six races on this date, with as many of the best Junior Drivers as we can contract to appear, AND there is no extra charge for admission.

A word for somebody you rarely see, and only hear about when there is a dispute. You will never hear of our lap-scorers because we do not have that sort of dispute; last Saturday and today we welcome Mr. Foxwell to the fold. He is regularly in the chair at our friendly-neighbour track, LONG EATON, so he will be used to lively racing ! He joins the team this week-end, and will be with us from time to time during the coming season, alternating with Friday Arnold and Len Porter.
