#### A GOOD START TO THE SEASON

Some of the lads who are here today will be here on Monday, and the latest news is that not only is Monday going to mark the return of the Wesley family to Senior racing, but there is a distinct possibility that one of Brafield's all-time greatest favourites will be racing here on the same day. This is, of course, purely hope at the moment, but if all goes well, we shall see 'DIRTY DENNIS' BURDETT-COUTTS here on Monday. It all depends on the Board of Control.


