



And then in tones of awe, one of the important people said, "We might get back to things like boar's heads". What a pity! That boar's head brought more roars from the crowd than have been heard very often since.

If it did reach the stage where scale models of Jayne Mansfield, the Brafield Badger, and wax statues of the Board of Control were seen to be appearing on the cars, then I would certainly say that it was absurd. Drivers, in my opinion, are too sensible to indulge in such idiocies, but apparently their leaders do not think so. But a little bit of individuality never hurt anybody, except lovers of dreary uniformity.


